Parents and Prospective Cheerleaders,

Welcome to Dominican's Cheerleading tryouts for the 2015-2016 school year. Please read over the following handouts and return the consent form by Tuesday, April 7th for current Dominican students; Monday, April 13th for incoming students. Please take time to review and discuss the cost and time commitments involved.

Remember that cheerleading is a yearlong activity that requires dedication and effort! Dominican High School Cheerleading is a competition squad, who also participates in pep rallies, recruitment and fundraising events, selected volleyball and basketball games, and selected Mardi Gras parades. Members must not participate in any other school sport or the spring musical if they make the team. This is due to the amount of practices they will miss if they are involved in these activities. If the member participates in other extracurricular activities they must not conflict with Dominican Cheerleading. Parents of cheerleaders who do not drive are responsible for providing or arranging transportation to and from practices and events promptly. Failure to do so may result in removal from the squad. Practices are often extended while preparing for certain events throughout the year. Your daughter will receive a calendar on Edline informing her of the dates and times. In addition, a positive attitude, cooperation, dependability, punctuality and the ability to work well with others as well as accept constructive criticism are all important qualities of a good cheerleader.

According to the Dominican High School Cheerleader Constitution, any student trying out for the squad must meet eligibility requirements. These requirements include good disciplinary standing and good academic standing (at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA). Any student not meeting these requirements will not be allowed to try out. Please read the following documents thoroughly and take all of this into consideration before completing the tryout process.

Dominican High School Cheerleader Tryouts Monday – Wednesday, April 13-14

Clinic (Monday & Tuesday April 13-214):

- 1. The clinic will be held from 3:30-5:00 pm. Girls are informed that they will be numbered and grouped upon arrival on tryout day.
- 2. Parental/Student Consent, Registration, and Permission slip forms as well as a \$10 tryout fee are due on Tuesday, April 7th for current Dominican students; by Monday, April 13th for incoming students. Students will not be allowed to participate in the clinic or try-outs if she doesn't have the permission slips signed by a parent or guardian in her possession on that day.
- 3. PARENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO STAY OR OBSERVE DURING THE CLINICS. IF PARENTS WOULD LIKE TO VIDEOTAPE MATERIAL FOR TRYOUT THEY ARE WELCOME TO DO SO AT 5PM, MONDAY OR TUESDAY, BUT NOT BEFORE.
- 4. Current cheerleader officers and senior members will instruct the girls in a cheer, chant, and dance. The instructors will be available for individual help during the clinic.
- 5. Monday: Meeting & begin learning material
- 6. Tuesday: Finish learning material, practice technique, & review
- 7. The clinic will end at 5:00 pm. Students MUST be picked up promptly at 5:00 pm.

Tryouts (Wednesday, April 15th):

- 1. Tryouts will be held from 4:30-6:30 pm. Again, all students must be picked up promptly. **Parents should plan to arrive at 6:00 pm in case try-outs end early.**
- 2. Students may not tryout if they have not attended both clinic days.
- 3. Tryouts are required for all students. Students must tryout every year while enrolled at Dominican High School.
- 4. Special treatment/recognition will not be given to previous squad members trying out.
- 5. Girls will sign in upon arrival.
- 6. There will be two to three qualified and objective judges.
- 7. The girls will be judged according to:
 - a. Entrance (enthusiasm, crowd appeal, and appearance)
 - b. Cheer/Chant (motion sharpness, voice, timing, placement, facials)
 - c. Dance (timing, placement, facials)
 - d. Physical Ability (jumps, stunting, tumbling)
 - e. Overall Performance
- 8. Girls may not practice while waiting to try out.
- 9. Girls must leave the room immediately after trying out. Students will wait in the Siena atrium.

- 10. Girls may repeat each routine only once.
- 11. No one will be allowed in the tryout room except the judges, the moderators, and the senior captains.

Results:

Results will be announced at the end of try-outs on Wednesday.

There will be an organizational meeting Thursday, April 23rd after school promptly at 3:30 p.m for the 2015-2016 Cheerleaders and their parents to discuss membership in the organization, summer practice/camp schedules and order cheerleader uniforms. This meeting will be mandatory for ALL cheerleaders. Each cheerleader must have a parent representative present at the meeting. Payment for camp, choreography, and June/July coaches' fees will be due at this time.
