Checklist

All parents and students must sign the 2021-2022 Student/Parent Handbook Form, AUP Technology Form, and Covid Waiver Form. Please bring all three forms signed on the day you register. All three forms can be found in the Summer Communication. Students who fail to provide these signed documents on registration day will not be allowed to proceed until all signed documents are obtained.

P.E. Uniform: All students were asked to preorder their P.E. uniforms online in May. Preordered P.E. uniforms will be distributed at registration. If you did not preorder P.E. uniforms, you may still order your uniforms through the Dominican website (click on Students, then Apparel), but your uniform will not be ready for delivery until after the start of the school year.

Seniors Only: Please review and SIGN your transcript. Please complete the activity resume sheet and diploma name slip. Please be prepared to turn in all three at registration on Wednesday, August 11.

Drivers: \$5.00 Parking Decal. Please be prepared to provide the license plate number along with the make, model, and color of the car you will be parking at school.

School Pictures: Pictures for yearbook and ID purposes will be taken on registration day. Families will receive a separate mailing from Barberito Photographers regarding information on purchasing these pictures.

Attire: Yearbook and ID pictures will be taken on registration day. The black V-neck sweater or ¼ zip pullover sweatshirt with full school uniform must be worn. Seniors will take pictures in their Senior sweaters, which will be distributed on August 11. Juniors may wear their red sweaters for pictures. Uniform skirts must be worn around the waist with the hemline falling no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. Moderation in hair color and style is expected. Hairstyles that involve an extreme/faddish color or cut are strictly prohibited. Only one earring per lobe and one necklace is allowed. Any other visible piercings, gauges, or body markings are strictly prohibited. Clean and polished shoes are expected to start the school year. **Parents, please ensure that your daughter is properly dressed for the school year beginning on registration day.** All students returning to school for activities on either August 11 or August 12 must be in full school uniform.

Sage Dining Pre-Paid Account: New students will be given a 6-digit unique ID on registration day. Parents may go to <https://www.mykidsspending.com/> and use the student unique ID # to establish an account.

Nametags: Additional nametags may be ordered on registration day for \$5.00 (cash or check made payable to St. Mary's Dominican High School). All new students are given a free nametag at registration. Nametag orders will not be accepted the first week of school. Please order any replacement or additional nametags at registration.

Calculators: Students enrolled in Algebra I or Geometry are required to have the TI 84 Plus or the TI 84 Plus Color Graphing Calculator. These calculators may be purchased separately or through the Dominican Math Department at the beginning of the school year. Forms will be sent home by your daughter's math teacher. Students in Pre-Algebra are required to have a basic calculator (addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division).
