TOPS Information

As stated above, please check to make sure the information on your transcript is correct, especially the **Social Security Number**. If this is not correct, your senior may not be processed correctly to receive her TOPS.

To Meet TOPS Requirements a Student Must:

- Complete the TOPS Core Curriculum
- Achieve a 2.50 GPA in those Core Classes and an ACT score of 20 (SAT 1020-1050)
 - For the Performance Award, 3.25 GPA in the Core Classes and 23 ACT (SAT 1130-1150)
 - o For the Honors Award, 3.50 GPA in the Core Classes and 27 ACT (SAT 1280-1300)
- Complete either the TOPS application or the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Enroll full-time in a Louisiana College/University upon graduation

If you have achieved one of these awards with the SAT, it is important for you to make sure you send your score to the TOPS office. Their code is 9019. You will do this through the SAT website, like you would send your score to a college/university.

We suggest creating a student hub account, located on the TOPS website (<u>www.mylosfa.la.gov</u>) to help you monitor your TOPS status throughout high school and college.

Dominican is not responsible for making sure that students qualify for TOPS. Although DHS does everything it can to be sure that all students meet the requirements for TOPS, the ultimate responsibility belongs with the student and the parent. Please make a thorough check of your records to avoid any possible disappointment.
