Thank you for making a valuable investment in your daughter's Dominican Catholic education. St. Mary's Dominican High School provides a distinctive formation and education that integrates faith and reason in search of Truth and serves as a robust foundation for life.

In order to have the resources to continue maintaining excellence in Catholic education, the Board of Directors, in consultation with our school Leadership Team, has approved an all-inclusive tuition of \$10,990 for the 2022-2023 school year. This represents a \$290 increase over the prior year.

St. Mary's Dominican High School continues to partner with Smart Tuition (recently acquired by Blackbaud Tuition Management) for the processing and collection of our families' tuition and fees. The \$1,000 deposit will be due in March 2022. Please make note of the following:

- **All automatic payments will be disabled in March. You must manually log on to your Blackbaud Tuition Management account and pay the \$1,000 deposit in the 2022-2023 school year.**

All current payment settings on your 2021-2022 Blackbaud Tuition Management account have been carried over to your 2022-2023 Blackbaud Tuition Management account.
