

Dear Parents,

Welcome to the Land of the Dominifans! We are very excited to see you at Walkin' on Walmsley. We know that you will meet new friends, become familiar with your new school, and most of all - have fun! Below is the information you need to come ready to spend your first week on Dominican's campus.

### REQUIRED Forms

- A COVID-19 permission slip and Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) form are required to attend the program. A student will not be allowed to participate if she does not have the forms on the first day.
- Please click here (link to forms ) for both forms and bring them with you to check-in.

### Check-In

- Check-in will take place on **Monday, July 18 beginning at 8:30 AM** in the Siena Center. Parents and students should enter campus from the Burdette Street gate. Walkin' on Walmsley activities will begin promptly at 9 AM.
- At check-in, students will receive their t-shirt and other program materials. Please note the required forms to be submitted at check-in.
- Due to construction in the neighborhood, Walmsley Avenue will be closed from the front door of Dominican through Fern Street. This includes the intersection of Walmsley and Burdette. Please see the map below.
  - Coming from Carrollton Avenue – use Fig Street to access Burdette Street.
  - Coming from Earhart Boulevard - use Burdette Street to access the gate.

### Arrival and Dismissal Time

- Walkin' on Walmsley is July 18 -22 from 9 AM to 3 PM.
- Students must be dropped off and picked up in the Burdette Street parking lot only.
- Students who arrive late or leave early must use the main entrance on Walmsley Avenue.
- Program activities begin each day at 9 AM. Students can be dropped off between 8:30 AM – 8:55 AM.
- Dismissal is at 3:00 p.m. There is no aftercare.
- Rainy day drop off and pick up procedures are the same.

### What to Wear

- Attire is casual. Each student will receive one Walkin' On Walmsley t-shirt with her registration.
- Students may wear a modest style of shorts, leggings, or jeans with a t-shirt. Other Dominican t-shirts are encouraged! The building can get cold at times, so a light jacket or sweatshirt is recommended. No halter or tank tops. No midriffs.
- Closed-toe shoes are required.

### Technology/Cell Phones

- Students will need to bring their **school device, charger, and stylus** to the program each day. You can find information on device specifications here (link to: <https://www.stmarysdominican.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/02/Technology-Letter-2-15-2022.pdf>).

- It is highly recommended to have a case for your device when you come to the program.
- The technology training portion of Walkin' on Walmsley includes installing programs and software onto the device, so the device brought to Walkin' on Walmsley must be the device the student plans to use during the school year.
- Please make sure that the student has the necessary rights to the computer to be able to install the required programs.
- Students who complete technology training during Walkin' on Walmsley do not have to attend the August 12 technology training.
- Students may bring their cell phones as long as they are powered off during the program.

### **Supplies/Materials To Bring**

- Each student should bring a pen, pencil, crayons, or colored pencils (any kind), pair of scissors, and a notebook to Dominican every day. Students do not need to buy new school supplies for this program. Supplies from previous years are acceptable. A bag or backpack is recommended to store the device and supplies.
- Students should bring a water bottle to use all day.
- Students may have time to set up their lockers on Friday, July 22. Typically, students bring locker shelves or any decorations for the inside of the locker. Students will also have time to set up their lockers in August.

### **Food/Lunch**

- Lunch is included with each student's registration. However, a student may bring her own lunch if she chooses. Microwaves are available.
- If a student has special dietary needs, she may bring from home whatever she needs for lunch.
- Water bottle filling stations are available throughout the school building. Bottled water, soda, and other drinks may be purchased from vending machines for \$1.00-\$1.50.
