The Glen plaid skirt is to be worn around the waist with the hemline falling to the top of the knee, all the way around the skirt. The waistband of the skirt is not to be rolled.

This change will ensure the skirts are worn appropriately and uniformly.

As stated in the handbook, "The purpose of a school uniform and regulations regarding dress and appearance is not to stifle individual freedom but to identify one as a student of Dominican. The student's appearance reflects on the school as well as herself and her family. Students are to wear the uniform with respect and dignity."
