Expanded Technique Clinic featuring Virginia Babin & Alison Dupré



Virginia Babin is a New Orleans, LA native She began her dance training at the age of 3 where she learned all styles of dance and competed for several years. In high school, Virginia was a member of the Dominican Debs for 5 years. While in college, teaching and choreographing became a huge part of her life. She recently graduated from LSU with a degree in General Business along with a Dance minor. For the past three years, she has been the Jazz choreographer for the

Dominican Debs, earning State Championship and nationally-ranked titles. She continues to teach and choreograph for studios and dance teams in the New Orleans and Baton Rouge areas. This past year, she was named as a coach for the Dominican Debs JV Dance Team.



Alison Dupré is a New Orleans, Louisiana native. She began dancing at the age of 2, receiving training in multiple dance styles. Alison was a five-year member of the St. Mary's Dominican Debs as well as co-captain for two years. She graduated in 2018 and attended Xavier University of Louisiana as a Biology major and Chemistry minor. Her leadership role and love of dance on Dominican Debs extended to Christian Brothers School dance team where she began to help coach during

her senior year of high school until 2022. Alison continues to work with the Dominican Debs, and choreographed their 2022 nationally ranked hip hop routine and 2023 and 2024 nationally ranked game day routine. Alison works with many dancers, teaching at different studios around the city, and choreographing pieces for both studio and dance team competitions.
