Dear Parents and Guardians,

Thank you for choosing St. Mary's Dominican High School for your daughter's Catholic education and formation. We pray that your daughter's high school years will be blessed with many opportunities to prepare for college and to grow in our community of faith.

In order to have the resources to continue maintaining excellence in Catholic education, the Board of Directors, in consultation with the school Leadership Team, has approved an all-inclusive tuition of \$11,800 for the 2024-2025 school year.

St. Mary's Dominican High School partners with Blackbaud Tuition Management for the processing and collection of our families' tuition and fees. With Blackbaud Tuition Management you will be able to select a payment plan and payment type that works best for you. All parents/guardians of new students will need to enroll online with Blackbaud Tuition Management. A \$1,000 deposit is due upon completion of activation and is due March 8, 2024. The remainder of the tuition will be collected and processed through Blackbaud Tuition Management beginning in June 2024.
