Parents and Prospective Color Guard Members,

Welcome to Dominican's Color Guard tryouts for the 2024-2025 school year. Please read over the following handouts and return the permission slip and consent forms to Mrs. Ferguson or Mrs. Knock by Tuesday, April 23rd. Please take time to review and discuss the cost and time commitments involved.

Remember that Dominican Color Guard is a yearlong activity that requires individual dedication and financial commitment. Dominican Color Guard is a competition team that performs at school pep rallies, parades, and recruitment events on campus, as well as off campus performances in Mardi Gras parades, state and regional competitions, and other performance opportunities that may arise through the year. Being a competitive team requires financial commitment. 2023-2024 team fees were \$1,600 plus Varsity purchases. 2024-2025 team fees will be finalized after auditions. If a member participates in other extracurricular activities, they must coordinate those activities with Dominican Color Guard. Parents of color guard members who do not drive are responsible for providing or arranging transportation to and from practices and events promptly. Parents and members will receive a monthly calendar informing them of the dates and times for practices and events. Effort must be made on the part of members and families to coordinate their schedules in conjunction with practice or performance commitments. In addition, a positive attitude, cooperation, dependability, punctuality, and the ability to work well with others as well as accept constructive criticism are all important qualities of a good color guard member. Failure to be in good standing with these things can result in removal from the team.

According to the Dominican High School Color Guard Constitution, any student trying out for the team must meet eligibility requirements. These requirements include good disciplinary standing and good academic standing (at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA). Any student not meeting these requirements will not be allowed to try out. Please read the following documents thoroughly and take all of this into consideration before completing the tryout process.

Dominican High School Color Guard Clinics and Tryouts Tuesday, April 23rd through Friday, April 26th

Clinics (Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday April 23rd – April 25th):

- 1. Clinics will be held from 3:30pm-5:30pm.
- 2. <u>Parental/Student Consent</u>, <u>Registration</u>, and <u>Permission slip</u> forms as well as a <u>\$10</u> tryout fee are due on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>April 23rd</u>.
- 3. Team instructors will be available for individual help during the clinics.
- 4. <u>Tuesday</u>: Meeting, stretch and warmups, learn beginner dance and flag skills, and begin learning audition routine.
- 5. <u>Wednesday:</u> stretch and warmups, review what was learned on Monday and continue learning audition routine.
- 6. **Thursday:** stretch & warmup, time to rep routine and work in small groups.
- 7. The clinic will end at 6:00pm. Students MUST be picked up promptly at 6:00pm.

Auditions (Friday, April 26th):

- 1. Tryouts will be held from 3:30pm-6:30pm. All students must be picked up promptly.
- 2. Students may not try out if they have not attended at least 1 of the 3 clinic days. Attending all 3 days is recommended.
- 3. Tryouts are required for all students (new & returning) enrolled at Dominican.
- 4. Special treatment/recognition will not be given to previous team members trying out.
- 5. Girls will sign in upon arrival.
- 6. There will be two to three qualified and objective judges.
- 7. The girls will be judged according to:
 - a. **Technique** (fundamentals of dance, performance posture & projection, fundamentals of flag, muscle tension & flexion, and timing/tempo)
 - b. **Comprehension** (memorization, attention to detail, understanding and retention of spatial, body, & equipment expectations in routine)
 - c. Performance Qualities (showmanship and effect)
 - d. **Attitude** (effort and recovery)
- 8. Girls must leave the room immediately after auditioning & wait until the audition is over.

9. No one will be allowed in the tryout room except the judges, and the moderators.
