Parents and Prospective Cheerleaders,

Welcome to Dominican's Cheerleading tryouts for the 2025-2026 school year. Please read over the following handouts and return the consent form by **Tuesday April 8th**. Please take time to review and discuss the cost and time commitments involved.

Remember that cheerleading is a yearlong activity that requires dedication and effort! Dominican High School Cheerleading is a squad that participates in pep rallies, recruitment and fundraising events, selected volleyball and basketball games, and selected Mardi Gras parades. Members must not participate in any other school sport, the robotics team, or the spring musical if they make the team. This is due to the number of practices they will miss if they are involved in these activities. If the member participates in other extracurricular activities, they must not conflict with Dominican Cheerleading. Parents of cheerleaders who do not drive are responsible for providing or arranging transportation to and from practices and events promptly. Failure to do so may result in removal from the squad. Practices are often extended while preparing for certain events throughout the year. Your daughter will receive a calendar informing her of the dates and times. In addition, a positive attitude, cooperation, dependability, punctuality, and the ability to work well with others as well as accept constructive criticism are all important qualities of a good cheerleader.

According to the Dominican High School Cheerleader Constitution, any student trying out for the squad must meet eligibility requirements. These requirements include good disciplinary standing and good academic standing (at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA). Any student not meeting these requirements will not be allowed to try out. Please read the following documents thoroughly and take all of this into consideration before completing the tryout process.

Dominican High School Cheerleader Clinics and Tryouts Tuesday- Thursday April 8th- April 10th

Clinic (Tuesday and Wednesday April 8th – April 9th):

- 1. The clinic will be held from 4:00 6:00 pm. Students MUST be picked up promptly at 6:00 pm.
- Parental/Student Consent, Registration, and Permission slip forms are due on Tuesday, April 8th.
 Students will not be allowed to participate in the clinic or try-outs if she doesn't have the permission slips signed by a parent or guardian in her possession on that day as well as a copy of her insurance card.
- 3. Current cheerleader officers and senior members will instruct the girls in a cheer, chant, and dance. The instructors will be available for individual help during the clinic.
- 4. **Tuesday:** Meeting & begin learning material; **Wednesday:** Practice technique & tumbling

Tryouts (Thursday, April 10th):

- 1. Tryouts will be held at 4:00 pm. Again, all students must be picked up promptly. **Parents should plan** to arrive at 5:30 pm in case try-outs end early.
- 2. Students may not tryout if they have not attended the clinic day.
- 3. Students should bring their \$10 tryout fee on this day
- 4. Tryouts are required for all students. Students must tryout every year while enrolled at Dominican.
- 5. Special treatment/recognition will not be given to previous squad members trying out.
- 6. Girls will sign in upon arrival.
- 7. There will be two to three qualified and objective judges.
- 8. The girls will be judged according to:
 - a. Entrance (enthusiasm, crowd appeal, and appearance)
 - b. Cheer/Chant (motion sharpness, voice, timing, placement, facials)
 - c. Dance (timing, placement, facials)
 - d. Physical Ability (jumps, stunting, tumbling)
 - e. Overall Performance
- 9. Girls may not practice while waiting to try out.
- 10. Girls must leave the room immediately after trying out. Students will wait in the Siena atrium.
- 11. Girls may repeat each routine only once.
- 12. No one will be allowed in the tryout room except the judges, and the moderators.
